

## SSC GD Constable Syllabus Scheme of Examination:

**Computer Based Examination:** consist of one objective type paper containing 100 questions carrying 100 marks, with the following composition:

- All questions will be of Objective Multiple Choice Type. The computer based examination will be conducted in English and Hindi only.
- There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this while answering the questions.

## SSC Constable GD Detailed Syllabus

- **General Intelligence and Reasoning:** observe and distinguish patterns will be tested through questions principally of non-verbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, spatial visualization, spatial memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-series, coding and decoding, etc.

- **General Knowledge and General Awareness** will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observations and ex their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Polity, Indian Constitution, and scientific Research etc. These Questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

- **Elementary Mathematics:** relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Mensuration, and Work, etc.

- **English/ Hindi:** Candidates' his basic comprehension would be tested.
